Prior notification of a concentration**(Case COMP/M.5949 — Deutsche Bank/Actavis)****Candidate case for simplified procedure****(Text with EEA relevance)**

1. On 18 August 2010, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 ⁽¹⁾ by which the undertaking Deutsche Bank AG (Germany) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Merger Regulation control of the whole of the undertaking Actavis Group hF ('Actavis', Iceland) by way of contract of management or any other means.
2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
 - Deutsche Bank AG: deposit and lending operations, securities deposit and custody services, payment services, private banking, asset management and investment banking for private individuals, companies and institutions,
 - Actavis: development, manufacture and sale of generic pharmaceuticals.
3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of the EC Merger Regulation. However, the final decision on this point is reserved. Pursuant to the Commission Notice on a simplified procedure for treatment of certain concentrations under the EC Merger Regulation ⁽²⁾ it should be noted that this case is a candidate for treatment under the procedure set out in the Notice.
4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
